

BOXES TYPICALLY INCLUDE MILK, JUICE, CANNED MEAT, POULTRY, OR FISH, OATS, READY-TO-EAT CEREAL, RICE, PASTA, DRY BEANS, PEANUT BUTTER, AND CANNED FRUITS AND VEGETABLES.



The Assassination & Funeral of Abraham Lincoln

This account has all the essentials of a murder mystery.

The difference is that this story is absolutely true. Even if history is not your favorite subject, you won't want to miss this program about our 16th President.



The narrative begins 4 years before the assassination of President Lincoln in 1865 and ends in 1963 with the death of the last person to have looked upon the face of President Lincoln.

The President's first funeral was in Washington, D.C. and was followed by 11 subsequent ceremonies over a period of,20 days.

The 1654 mile funeral procession included a stop in York, PA.

36 years later, President Lincoln was finally laid to rest for the last time after having been moved 17 times since first being entombed in Springfield, Illinois.

In response to a request from an Illinois museum to build a replica of Lincoln's coffin for an exhibit, Batesville Casket Company of Indiana built 5 replica coffins. One is part of the permanent collection at the Abraham Lincoln Presidential Library and Museum in Springfield, Illinois. One is at Heffner's.
