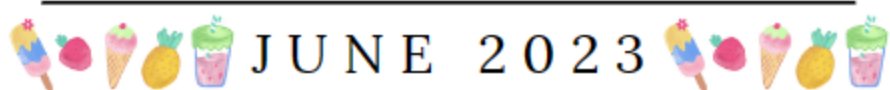

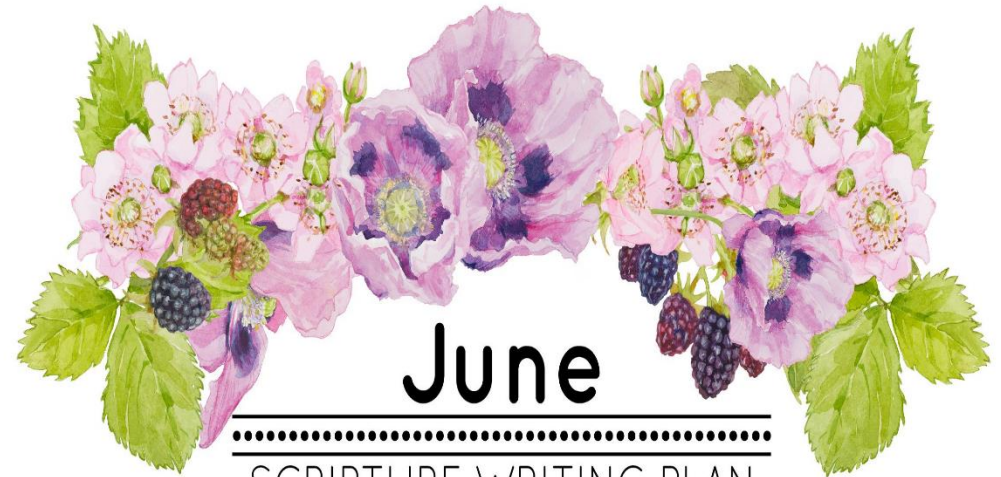

Remember, you must pre-register for your meal.

This is to ensure that we order enough meals. Lunch will be served inside by takeout containers. You are welcome to eat inside the building, or take your meal to go. If you are able, we prefer you walk inside to pick up your lunch (but respect if you are unable/or don't feel comfortable doing so). Lunch will

be served Monday through Friday, **at approximately 11:30**. It is your responsibility to Pre-Register for your own meals (**We will train you on Co-Pilot and ask that you pre-register at least two business days in advance**).

Lunches cannot be held for the following day due to limited refrigerator space. With **our limited operating hours of 9am-2pm**, we are hopeful you will join us inside! Lunch will be served at 11:30 promptly following our Meal Time prayer (please know that this is subject to change based on delivery times from Nutrition Group- our food provider. If you are

will call you to retrieve your lunch by the table you are seated at (if you choose to eat inside). For those who are grabbing their meals and leaving, it is important that you are here between **11:30 and NOON** to ensure

you receive your meal. **After noon, we start distributing meals on a first come, first served basis.**

2023 Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program

Distribution will be IN-PERSON ONLY from June 1 – Sept 30.

**** NO vouchers will be mailed, NO application is needed****

ELIGIBILITY: Must show proof of AGE & RESIDENCY at distribution site

(Driver's license or PA ID are recommended)

- Must be 60 years of age by December 31, 2023
- Must be a York County resident
- 2023 **Gross Annual Income** can be no more than: (No documentation needed)
 - \$ 26,973 (\$2,248/ month) for individual
 - \$ 36,482 (\$3,040/ month) for a 2 person household
 - \$ 45,991 (\$3,833/ month) for a 3 person household

Each eligible person may receive the SFMNP \$50 only once per year.

Proxy forms are available for anyone who physically cannot come to the locations.

ID for the eligible person and proxy are required. Those forms can be obtained:

FRAUD ALERT – AUTOMATIC WITHDRAWS

Fraudulent telemarketers have found yet another way to steal your money, this time from your checking account. Consumers across the country are complaining about unauthorized debits (withdrawals) from their checking accounts. Automatic debiting of your checking account can be a legitimate payment method; many people pay mortgages or make car payments this way. But the system is being abused by fraudulent telemarketers. Therefore, if a caller asks for your checking account number or other information printed on your check, you should follow the same warning that applies to your credit card number. Do not give out checking account information over the phone unless you are familiar with the company and agree to pay for something.

Remember, if you give your checking account number over the phone to a stranger for "verification" or "computer purposes," that person could use it to improperly take money from your checking account.

How To Protect Yourself

- Don't give out your checking account number over the phone unless you know the company and understand why the information is necessary.
- If someone says they are taping your call, ask why. Don't be afraid to ask questions.
- Companies do not ask for your bank account information unless you have expressly agreed to this payment method.

Secret Pal

Please make sure that if you are a part of the Secret Pal program that you are keeping in touch with your Secret Pal throughout the year. While gifts are not mandatory, it is required of you (at the very minimum) to send a card.
